

Road User charge - Electronic vignette only

Lithuania

As of 21 August 2018 only electronic vignettes are available for buses (M2-M3), heavy vehicles (N1-N3) and their combinations as well as special road vehicles at A1–A18 primary roads. The transitional period started in the end of February 2018 when both electronic and paper vignettes were in use has ended. The paper vignettes issued before 21 August can be in use only until the end of their validation.

Electronic Vignette means an electronic record in the National Traffic Information System confirming the fact of payment of Road User Charges. Electronic record contains information about the date of vignette acquisition, its validity period (hours and minutes accuracy), category and vehicle registration plate for which the electronic vignette has been issued.

There are four types of electronic vignettes: daily, weekly, monthly and yearly. Road users are liable for the accuracy of information provided when acquiring an electronic vignette.

Electronic vignettes are distributed on a website or at sales points.
