Yesterday **Serbia EXEMPTED transport of goods** from restriction and measures due to the CORONA.

Healthy checks will be still on force and inspector will approve or forbid further driving in case of suspicion on virus.

Only Bezdan, Sot and Ljuba are closed (SRB-HR) for transport of goods.

We are waiting more news today.

We also closed a lot of border crossings but they are 99% small passenger border crossings as follows:

CLOSED BORDER CROSSINGS FOR PASSENGER TRANSPORT

Ministry of Interior of Republic of Serbia has published a list of closed border crossings.

Closed border crossings with **Hungary** are: Rastina, Bajmok, Bački Vinogradi, Horgoš 2, Đala, Rabe.

Closed border crossings with **Romania** are: Vrbica, Nakovo, Jaša Tomić, Kaluđerovo, Đerdap 2.

Closed border crossings with **Bulgaria** are: Mokranje, Strezimirovci, Ribarci.

Closed border crossings with **Macedonia** are: Prohor Pčinjski, Goleš – Golema Crkoriya, Godovo, Vrbnica, Jabuka

Closed border crossings with **Bosnia and Herzegovina** are: Priboj, Carevo polje, Mali Zvornik.

Closed border crossings with **Croatia** are: Sot, Ljuba, Neštin, Bogojevo, Apatin, Bezdan, Berkasovo.
